

Cotswold Hilly 100 Relay Race Route Directions – Leg 1



DANGER - all legs follow NARROW LANES/MAIN ROADS

PARKING – do not block the road or cover the changeover points

Please be considerate to other traffic and users of the countryside.

ABBREVIATIONS TL – turn left TR – turn right SO – straight on

Directions to Start of Leg 1

The Fountain Clock (also known as The American Fountain) is on Rother Street in the Town Centre on the corner where Greenhill Street, Windsor Street and Rother Street all meet (on the open paved area used for car parking or week-end markets).

The nearest available public toilets at the early start time are on Waterside near the river Avon (road that the Theatre is on).
